Application Process

- Create your Self-reported Student Academic Record (SSAR) at admissions.fsu.edu using your official high school transcript. To learn about the SSAR, visit admissions.fsu.edu/freshman/admissions/ssar.cfm.
- Apply online at admissions.fsu.edu/undergradapp/. This year's essay topics are described below. Applicants should choose one topic.
 - Describe an experience from your life that either demonstrates your character or helped shape it.
 - Describe a time when you made a meaningful contribution to others in which the greater good was your focus. Discuss the challenges and rewards of making your contribution.
 - Has there been a time when you've had a long-cherished or accepted belief challenged? How did you respond? How did the challenge affect your beliefs?
- Submit official ACT (#0734) and/or SAT (#5219) results for **every** test taken.
- Submit the Florida Residency Declaration Form at admissions.fsu.edu/residency/.
- Submit FAFSA, available in October.
- Contact the academic department directly if majoring in dance, film (animation or production), music, or theatre.
- Log in to the Online Status Check regularly to monitor the status of your application at admissions.fsu.edu/StatusCheck/.

Scholarships

High achieving students might be eligible for one of our merit-based scholarships and/or out-of-state tuition waivers, regardless of financial circumstances. Students admitted in December will have priority consideration for our admissions scholarships. Financial Assistance

Florida State offers admission to students on a 'need-blind' basis. Your ability to pay has no bearing on our admission decision. To apply for need-based aid, you must complete the 2017-2018 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) in October, but no later than December 1, 2016. Students can use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool to import their parent/legal guardian tax information onto their FAFSA. 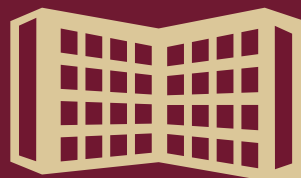
