ACTIVATE YOUR FSUID

FSU Information Technology Services will send you an email with your unique FSUID and email address. Visit my.fsu.edu, click "Manage FSUID/Password," and follow the steps to activate your FSUID. For detailed instructions, see our guide at fla.st/IOL94A3W.

COMPLETE YOUR HOUSING CONTRACT

Complete your housing contract in the myHousing Portal and learn about living on campus by visiting housing.fsu.edu.

- **You are required to complete a housing contract for Summer B. The contract opens in early March and closes on May 1, 2025.**
- **If you want to continue living on campus in the fall, you must also complete a Fall 2025/Spring 2026 housing contract which opens in late February and closes on May 1, 2025.**

COMPLETE YOUR CARE PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT

If you are ready to accept your place in the CARE Summer Bridge Program, submit your CARE Participation Agreement as soon as possible, but no later than **May 1, 2025**. Submit this form by logging in to your Application Status Check at admissions.fsu.edu/statuscheck.

REGISTER FOR YOUR ORIENTATION SESSION

All CARE Summer Bridge students attend the same mandatory orientation session that takes place one week before summer classes begin. The Summer B session starts June 23, 2025. **Orientation registration will open on January 15, 2025.** You must first complete and submit your CARE Participation Agreement before you can register for orientation.

Your financial aid award will cover your orientation fee, but the guest fee for family member(s) will be your responsibility. **Students must register for orientation by May 5, 2025.** For more information, visit nsfp.fsu.edu/orientation.

COMPLETE YOUR FAFSA

As a CARE Summer Bridge student, you must submit a FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) for **both** the 2024/25 and 2025/26 academic year. **Both FAFSAs are due by March 15, 2025 and can be completed at studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa.**

Note: The Office of Financial Aid may request additional documents to verify your eligibility. Check your email or "To-Do List" at my.fsu.edu and submit any requested documents by the deadline to maintain your admission status.

SUBMIT PROOF OF YOUR HEALTH INSURANCE

FSU requires all full-time and main campus students to show proof of health insurance coverage. Visit studentinsurance.fsu.edu for details, instructions, and information on the FSU-sponsored plan through United Healthcare Student Resources.

SUBMIT YOUR IMMUNIZATION FORM

Before you can register for classes at orientation, you must complete our immunization form showing proof of two MMR vaccines and either proof of or a waiver for Hepatitis B and Meningococcal Meningitis vaccines. For more information and access to the form, visit studentinsurance.fsu.edu.

Florida Residency Declaration Form

SSAR Update

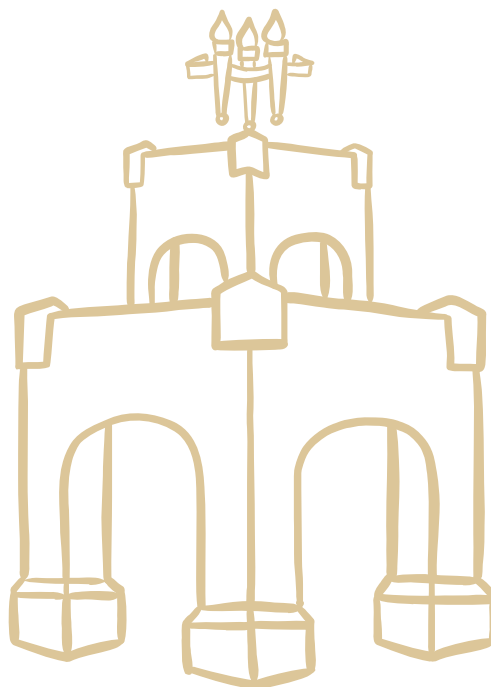
Update your Self-Reported Student Academic Record (SSAR) with your final, senior-year grades by logging on to the SSAR website at ssar.selfreportedtranscript.com/login.aspx. After you have entered your information, click the Complete button in the Review/Submit section. **If you don't click the Complete button, FSU will not receive your updated information. All senior grades must be updated on your SSAR by July 15, 2025.**

Final High School Transcripts, Final College Transcripts, and Official Test Scores

Request your final high school transcript with your graduation date and your official college transcript with dual enrollment coursework to be sent to FSU. Your high school is not responsible for sending your college transcript. Request all official ACT, CLT, and SAT test scores to be sent to FSU. **All official transcripts and test scores must be received by July 15, 2025.**

REVIEW YOUR CONDITIONS OF ADMISSION

We will reevaluate your application after receiving all official records. Discrepancies between official and self-reported grades and/or test scores may result in your acceptance being rescinded. Additionally, your admission may be rescinded if you earn any senior-year grades below a C, and/or if your cumulative college GPA is below 2.00 for dual enrollment courses.
