ACTIVATE YOUR FSUID

FSU Information Technology Services will send you an email with your unique FSUID and email address. Visit my.fsu.edu, click "Manage FSUID/Password," and follow the steps to activate your FSUID. For detailed instructions, see our guide at fla.st/IOL94A3W.

COMPLETE YOUR HOUSING CONTRACT

Complete your housing contract in the myHousing Portal and learn about living on campus by visiting housing.fsu.edu.

- **The Fall 2025/Spring 2026 housing contract will open for admitted students in late February and close on May 1, 2025.**

PAY YOUR ADMISSION DEPOSIT

You should pay your \$200 non-refundable admission deposit as soon as you decide to attend FSU, but no later than May 1, 2025. Log in to your Application Status Check at admissions.fsu.edu/statuscheck to pay the admission deposit. For detailed instructions, see our "How to Pay Your Deposit Guide" at fla.st/DU7INMRL.

REGISTER FOR YOUR ORIENTATION SESSION

After activating your FSUID and paying your \$200 non-refundable admission deposit, you must register for orientation. This mandatory, multi-step process opens on **January 15, 2025**. Space for each session is limited, so register as early as possible. **Registration and payment are due by May 5, 2025.** For more information, visit nsfp.fsu.edu/orientation.

SUBMIT PROOF OF YOUR HEALTH INSURANCE

FSU requires all domestic full-time, main campus students and all international students with F or J visas to show proof of health insurance coverage. Visit studentinsurance.fsu.edu for details, instructions, and information on the FSU-sponsored plan through United Healthcare Student Resources.

SUBMIT YOUR IMMUNIZATION FORM

Before you can register for classes at orientation, you must complete our immunization form showing proof of two MMR vaccines and either proof of or a waiver for Hepatitis B and Meningococcal Meningitis vaccines. For details and access to the form, visit studentinsurance.fsu.edu.





COMPLETE YOUR FAFSA

To be considered for need-based financial aid, you must first submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa. **Complete the 2025/26 FAFSA for Fall 2025 and Spring 2026 financial aid.** Learn more at financialaid.fsu.edu/apply-aid/new-noles.



SELECT YOUR MEAL PLAN

CHOOSE YOUR ENGAGE 100 COURSE

Every first-year student must enroll in an Engage 100 course in their first semester. Engage 100 helps you connect with new students and a peer mentor, explore social and academic opportunities, and dive into university life. Before orientation, visit engage100.fsu.edu to review the course options. Students in CARE Summer Bridge, QUEST, the Honors Program, UROP, Living-Learning Communities, and some academic programs will take a specific course that counts as their Engage 100 course.

FINALIZE YOUR ADMISSION

Florida Residency Declaration Form

All students who wish to claim Florida residency for tuition purposes must complete the residency declaration form before attending orientation. If you have not already completed your form, visit your Application Status Check at admissions.fsu.edu/statuscheck to complete this task.

SSAR Update

Update your Self-Reported Student Academic Record (SSAR) with your final, senior-year grades by logging in to the SSAR website at ssar.selfreportedtranscript.com/login.aspx. After you have entered your information, click the Complete button at the bottom of the Review/Submit section. **If you don't click the Complete button, FSU will not receive your updated information. All senior grades must be updated on your SSAR by July 15, 2025.**

Final High School Transcripts and Final College Transcripts

Request your final high school transcript with your graduation date and your final official college transcript with your AA degree posted to be sent to FSU. Your high school is not responsible for sending your college transcript. **All final transcripts must be received by July 15, 2025. If you did not earn the AA degree, you must contact the Office of Admissions immediately. Failure to do so will result in the offer of admission being rescinded.**

REVIEW YOUR CONDITIONS OF ADMISSION

We will reevaluate your application after receiving all official records. Discrepancies between self-reported and official transcripts may result in your offer of admission being rescinded. Your conditions of admission include: earning an Associate in Arts degree from a Florida public college no later than the date of your high school graduation and earning no senior-year grades below a C. Contact the Office of Admissions if you are concerned about not meeting your conditions of admission.
