To prepare for your arrival on campus, please complete the following items below.

### ACTIVATE YOUR FSUID

A few days after you have accepted your FSU Next offer, FSU Information Technology Services will send you an email with your unique FSUID and email address. Visit [my.fsu.edu](https://my.fsu.edu), click "Manage FSUID/Password," and follow the steps to activate your FSUID. ### FIND YOUR OFF-CAMPUS HOUSING

Off-campus housing listings can be found at [offcampushousing.fsu.edu](https://offcampushousing.fsu.edu). Confirm that your move-in date is **before** your fall term start date. If you are bringing a vehicle in the fall, confirm parking availability with your off-campus housing option early.

Tallahassee State College (TSC) and FSU are unable to offer you on-campus housing in the fall. **Spring on-campus housing is very limited and not guaranteed.** Off-campus housing fills up very quickly, so do not delay your search.

### REGISTER FOR YOUR ORIENTATION SESSION

After activating your FSUID, you must register for orientation. This mandatory, multi-step process opens on **October 1, 2025**. Space for each session is limited, so register as early as possible. For more information, visit [nsfp.fsu.edu/orientation](https://nsfp.fsu.edu/orientation).



### COMPLETE YOUR FAFSA

Applying for need-based financial aid requires you to submit the 2025/26 FAFSA available at [studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa](https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa).

- **Make sure that FSU and TSC are both listed on your FAFSA application.**

If you receive a Florida Bright Futures scholarship, you must let the Florida Department of Education know that you will be attending TSC in the fall and FSU for the spring. You can update this information by logging into your account at [floridastudentfinancialaidsg.org](https://floridastudentfinancialaidsg.org) or call toll-free at 888-827-2004. ### SUBMIT PROOF OF YOUR HEALTH INSURANCE

FSU requires all domestic full-time, main campus students and all international students with F or J visas to show proof of health insurance coverage. Visit [studentinsurance.fsu.edu](https://studentinsurance.fsu.edu) for details, instructions, and information on the FSU-sponsored plan through United Healthcare Student Resources.

### SUBMIT YOUR IMMUNIZATION FORM

Before you attend your fall FSU course, "Gateway to Garnet and Gold," you will need to complete our immunization form showing proof of two MMR vaccines and either proof of or a waiver for Hepatitis B and Meningococcal Meningitis vaccines. You are not required to purchase a meal plan, but with 30 different dining locations on campus and a number of varied meal plan options, you may find it convenient. ## PAY FALL FSU COURSE TUITION

"Gateway to Garnet and Gold" is a required course for the FSU Next Program taken in-person in the fall at the FSU Tallahassee campus. ## DON'T FORGET

### FINALIZE YOUR ADMISSION

#### Florida Residency Declaration Form

All students who wish to claim Florida residency for tuition purposes must complete the residency declaration form before attending orientation. If you have not already completed your form, visit your Application Status Check at [admissions.fsu.edu/statuscheck](http://admissions.fsu.edu/statuscheck) to complete this task.

#### SSAR Update

Update your Self-Reported Student Academic Record (SSAR) with your final, senior-year grades by logging in to the SSAR website at [ssar.selfreportedtranscript.com/login.aspx](http://ssar.selfreportedtranscript.com/login.aspx).

After you have entered your information, click the Complete button at the bottom of the Review/Submit section. **If you don't click the Complete button, FSU will not receive your updated information. All senior grades must be updated on your SSAR by July 15, 2025.**

#### Final High School Transcripts, Final College Transcripts, and Official Test Scores

Request your final high school transcript with your graduation date and your official college transcript with dual enrollment coursework to be sent to FSU. Your high school is not responsible for sending your college transcript. Request all official ACT, CLT, and SAT test scores to be sent to FSU. **All final transcripts and test scores must be received by July 15, 2025.**

**At the end of the Fall 2025 term, you must send an official, final college transcript from TSC to FSU Admissions to show you have met all admission conditions. We will automatically pull your FSU course transcript to confirm if you have met all admission conditions.**

### REVIEW YOUR CONDITIONS OF ADMISSION

We will reevaluate your application after receiving all official records. Discrepancies between self-reported and official test scores and/or transcripts may result in your offer of admission being rescinded. Your conditions of admission include: earning no senior-year grades below a C, and/or your dual enrollment GPA should not fall below a 2.00. Contact the Office of Admissions if you are concerned about not meeting your conditions of admission.

#### 12 to 15 Hour Requirement at TSC

Enroll in a minimum of 12 to 15 credit hours at TSC in the fall. If you take college courses in the summer, you must still take 12 to 15 semester hours in the fall. Please review the Academic Program Guide at [academic-guide.fsu.edu](http://academic-guide.fsu.edu) for major requirements and recommended college courses. Students will also be enrolled in the in-person, one-hour "Gateway to Garnet and Gold" course at FSU in the fall. Accelerated credit (AICE, AP, IB, CLEP, and/or dual enrollment) cannot count towards your 12 to 15 hour requirement. #### GPA Requirement

Earn a minimum 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale) college grade point average in your fall classes with no grade below C. If you take classes in the summer, your college GPA for that term must also be 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale) with no grade below C. If you take summer classes, you are required to have an official transcript sent to FSU Admissions before the start of the fall term. A grade of "Satisfactory" must be earned in the "Gateway to Garnet and Gold" course at FSU.

#### English Requirement

Enroll in ENC 1101 (the first English composition class) unless you have earned comparable college credit for English composition through AICE, AP, IB, CLEP, and/or dual enrollment. Refer to Accelerated Credit at [admissions.fsu.edu/first-year/credit](http://admissions.fsu.edu/first-year/credit) for college credit awarded through acceleration.

#### Math Requirement

Enroll in the required math for your major (MAC 1105, MGF 1130, or MGF 1131) unless you have earned comparable or higher-level college credit for math through AICE, AP, IB, CLEP, and/or dual enrollment. Refer to Accelerated Credit at [admissions.fsu.edu/first-year/credit](http://admissions.fsu.edu/first-year/credit) for college credit awarded through acceleration. Refer to the Academic Program Guide at [academic-guide.fsu.edu](http://academic-guide.fsu.edu) for your major's math requirement.
