FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

To be considered for financial aid, you must complete the 2025-2026 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at <u>studentaid.gov</u>. Students admitted for the summer term should complete both the 2024-2025 **AND** the 2025-2026 FAFSA. <u>financialaid.fsu.edu/apply-aid/prospective-noles</u>

SCHOLARSHIPS

Admitted students are automatically considered for merit-based scholarships, regardless of financial circumstances. A separate application is not required. Scholarships are limited, so students should apply for admission by December 1. *admissions.fsu.edu/first-year/scholarships*
